

DAIRY GOATS – YQCA Required

OVERALL DAIRY GOAT RULES: (Be familiar with General Livestock Rules)

- 1) Goats must be owned, fed, and cared for by exhibitor. Exhibitor must own animal by May 15.
- 2) Animals in this department must be properly identified in 4-H Online by May 15.
- 3) Goats may only be shown in one department. Pet goats should be entered in the Pet Department. Meat goats should be entered in the Meat Goat Department.
- 4) All sexually intact goats must be identified with an individual Scrapie Flock of Origin identification tag or by an official registered tattoo.
- 5) All dairy exhibitors need to have Youth for Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) Certification by June 15.
- 6) Dairy goats with horns will not be allowed to exhibit.
- 7) Dairy goats (not including milking goats) must be stalled on the fairgrounds from check-in until Sunday evening check-out..
Check-out for Dairy will be Sunday at 4:30 pm. See General Livestock Rules for more on the check-out process.

Dairy Goat Classes

22100: Jr. Doe, under 6 mo. (recommended at least 3 mo. of age)

22110: Jr. Doe, 6 mo. to 1 year old (not in milk)

22120: Sr. Doe- over 1 year of age (first or succeeding lactation)

Showmanship (see General Showmanship Contest rules) Exhibitors will be automatically entered into the appropriate Showmanship class and should notify the Superintendent or Fair Staff if they choose not to participate on the day of the show.
Goats shown in showmanship must be shown in an exhibition class by the exhibitor.
