## **Clothing Events**

District clothing event participants are showcased in a style show. This show is divided into two sessions and will take place on **Saturday**, **September 10**. The first session will begin at 1:00 p.m. and the second session will begin at 3:00 p.m. Each session will include a combination of Fashion Review, Clothing Selection, and \$15 Challenge participants. Exhibitors should report to the 4-H Building Auditorium at least 30 minutes prior to the start of their session to check in. Exhibitors can plan to come dressed in their outfits or bring their outfits along and change in the provided dressing rooms.

### **Working Exhibits**

These make-and-take demonstrations will take place on **Saturday, September 10**, from 11:00 am to 12:pm or 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm., and **Saturday, September 17**, during the same time slots. Working Exhibits will be set up in the 4-H Exhibit Building and open to the public. A table and easel will be provided for each working exhibit. Exhibitors should bring enough supplies for 75 to 100 of their demonstrated projects. The communications judge will move around the tables during the presentation time and conduct brief conference judging sessions with each exhibitor following the demonstrations. Please refer to the communications schedule on the website for the correct time and plan to arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled time.

### **Educational Presentation**

District educational presentations will begin at 10:00 am on **Saturday, September 17**, in the 4-H Building Auditorium. Checkin for all educational presentation exhibitors begins at 9:30 am, with presentations starting promptly at 10:00 am. Following their presentation, each exhibitor will participate in a peer review of the presentation immediately following their own. A table, easel, projector, and mirrored demonstration table are all available if needed. If you plan to use a PowerPoint or other file as part of your presentation, please ensure that it is downloaded in a Windows compatible format on a USB drive.

#### **Share the Fun**

Share the fun acts will begin at 12:00 pm on **Sunday, September 18**, in the 4-H Building Auditorium. Check-in for all Share the Fun exhibitors begins at 11:30 am, with acts starting promptly at 12:00 pm. Exhibitors will present in the order listed on the schedule on the Clay County Extension website. There are no assigned times for the acts, so please plan to line up in the backstage area at least 2-3 acts before your turn.

#### **Pride of Iowa**

Pride of Iowa demonstrations will begin at 2:30 pm on **Sunday, September 18,** in the 4-H Building Auditorium. Check-in for all Pride of Iowa exhibitors begins at 2:00 pm, with demonstrations beginning immediately following all Share the Fun acts. Exhibitors will present in the order listed on the schedule on the Clay County Extension website. A mirrored demonstration table, easel, microwave, blender, and other small kitchen gadgets will be available. Clay County 4-H volunteers will also be available to assist exhibitors before and after demonstrations.
