3. What leadership to you? Highlight specific opportunities you had within this project area and any other elected or voluntary leadership you have taken on locally or beyond.
4. Share how your 4-H participation, individually or as part of a group, has met the needs of others.
5. How do you think your 4-H project experiences will affect your future?
