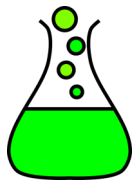

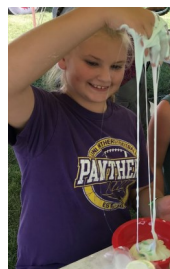
STEM Sport Games

Kids in the Kitchen
