RE: Contest Update and Entry Process

Exhibitors,

We are working with Tyson Fresh Meats for our beef carcass contest at their Joslin, IL plant and Maquoketa Livestock Exchange. Please include your email and cell phone number on your entry form so we may notify you of any last-minute changes. The following is an overview of how we plan to implement the 2023 Clinton County Carcass Contest.

1. Again, this year we will be doing pre-entries only (NO EXCEPTIONS). Entries are due June 30<sup>th</sup> as described below. We MUST have an accurate count of all animals by this deadline so please be sure you deliver the exact number of calves you entered.
  - a. The Open Class entry fee is \$50 this year and will be deducted from your cattle check. Please mail the enclosed entry form to the Clinton County Fair Office to enter.
  - b. 4-H/FFA entries must enter the contest through Fair Entry before June 30<sup>th</sup>. If a 4-H/FFA member wants to also enter the Open Show, they must ALSO fill out a copy of the enclosed form and mail it to the Fair Office.
2. Tyson requires the Market Beef Affidavit and Prohibited Feed/Antibiotics form be completed and returned when the calves are delivered to the sale barn. Please confirm that youth exhibitors are YQCA certified, and if parents are BQA certified. We will need the BQA number of all open class exhibitors on this form. Include both the 4-H or home tag and EID tags on the forms, as applicable. Complete the back with any medical treatments, implants, feed additives given, dates, etc. If you have not given any vaccinations or implants, please note "NA" rather than just leave it all blank. Please have this form completed prior to arrival to minimize time on show day.
3. **Exhibitors will deliver their calves to the Maquoketa Livestock Exchange on Sunday, July 9<sup>th</sup> between 3 and 4:30 pm. The show will begin at 5 pm.**
4. Depending on ability of the plant, an electronic ID (EID) tag will be used in all cattle to collect the carcass data. However, in the case of the plant's reader not working adequately, Lee Denzer will be employed to transfer the visual tags.
5. At the sale barn, calves will be tagged, weighed, judged and loaded to ship to Tyson Fresh Meats at Joslin where they will be harvested the next morning.
6. Calves will be harvested, carcasses will be electronically measured for ribeye area & back fat, quality graded, and the data will be sent to Denise Schwab for calculations.
7. Check Deductions
  - a. \$50 entry fee (Open Show only)
  - b. \$4 charge for the electronic tag OR \$15 for physical tag transfer (There is NO fee for the carcass data.)
  - c. \$2 per head Beef Checkoff
  - d. Dark Cutter Program fee (\$0.50/cwt live so a 1400-pound steer would be \$7), which helps reimburse exhibitors whose animal grades as a dark cutter.

As a youth livestock producer, I understand that I have an obligation to be a responsible producer and that all animals will enter the food chain and become edible food products for the consuming public. This subjects every exhibit animal to all state and federal regulations involving proper drug usage and all Food & Drug Administration, Animal Plant Health Inspection Service, Food Safety Inspection Service, and Environmental Protection Agency regulations.

- We, the undersigned, certify that we have **read, understand and will abide by** all rules and regulations of the local county 4-H & FFA fair, or the 4-H division of the State Fair. We agree to the condition that these exhibit animals (identified on this form) may be screened for violative residues and foreign substances. Also, as a condition of entry, exhibitor agrees to a background check for any past disqualification from other livestock shows.
- We have completed the Treatment Records information on the back of this form for any injectable, water, or feed medication, pesticide or other substance that has been administered to exhibit animals. Use of these products may require additional time to meet legal withdrawal limits before harvest.
- We certify that our exhibit animals have completed any withdrawal time relative to the administration of any legal drug, vaccine or other substance, and are in compliance with applicable FDA and USDA regulations (and similar state regulations) concerning drug residues and withdrawal periods.
- We certify that these exhibit animals have not received drugs that are not in compliance with label indications or, if applicable, the requirements of the regulations codifying the Animal Medicinal Drug Use Clarification Act amendment to the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic act (under the direction of a valid Veterinary/Client/Patient relationship).
- If violations are detected, appropriate state and federal authorities will be notified, and regulatory action can be expected. Also exhibitors will be subjected to penalties as determined by show management.
- Effective 4/1/01 due to concerns of BSE. - Any and all rations fed to cattle have not been fed "prohibited" mammalian protein (i.e. ruminant meat & bone meal) as defined by FDA CFR 589.2000.
- Any and all antibiotics used have been used (i) in accordance with guidelines for responsible use of antibiotics issued by World Health Organization (WHO), World Organization for Animal Health (OIE) and the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA), (ii) administered under the auspices of a veterinarian, (iii) in compliance with FDA regulations, and (iv) have not been used solely for the purpose of growth promotion.
- Supplier's cattle have at all times been handled properly, humanely, and in strict compliance with (i) industry standards relating to animal health and welfare, (ii) all applicable federal, state, local laws, and (iii) in compliance with Tyson's Zero Tolerance Policy, Animal Welfare Reporting, and Animal Welfare training policies.

This affidavit shall remain in effect until revoked in writing by the undersigned Supplier and is delivered to Tyson. Failure to have a current, signed affidavit on-record is cause for Tyson to refuse to slaughter any cattle under Supplier's authority, direction and/or ownership. Supplier shall keep the yellow copy of this affidavit for his/her/its records.
