The purpose of the tournament is to provide recreation and a chance for 4-H'ers to become acquainted with other 4-H'ers in the county. Any profits gained from the tournament, after all expenses are paid, will be put into the Clinton County 4-H Foundation.

Clinton County 4-H Basketball Rules

All Iowa High School Association rules for basketball apply with the following exceptions:

1. All games will be played with two 18 min halves, three min half time, and 5 min between games. If time is an issue we will decrease time allotted between games. Continuous clock format will be used for all games except the last 2 minutes of the end of 2nd half. If a team is ahead by 20+ points in the second half, continuous clock will remain during the last 2 min.
2. Over time – one two-minute overtime will be played (first minute will be continuous clock and clock will stop with dead ball for the last minute). If game is still tied at end of OT sudden death will take place (first to score)
3. If games are running ahead of schedule, we will start early. Be ready 25 min prior to scheduled start time.
4. Girl's size ball will be used for all divisions. No warm-up balls provided
5. Pressing rules – NO Full court press for Jr. division except last 2 min of game (unless there is a 20 point lead). Int and Sr divisions may full court press unless there is a 20 point lead.
6. Free throws – normal 1 and 1 after 7 team fouls. Double bonus after 10 team fouls
7. Time outs – Three 30 sec time outs per game will be allowed per team.
8. Technical fouls will result in 2 points and possession of the ball. A 2nd tech foul by player or coach will result in removal from tournament. Intentional fouls will not be automatic points, teams will shoot 2 free throws and then obtain possession of the ball.
9. No zone defense for Jr. division.
10. If your division has pool play placing will be determined by Head to Head – Fewest points allowed – then Point differential (10 max)
