

Chuck Goddard Memorial Scholarship

Background Information: The Chuck Goddard Memorial Scholarship was established in 2021 in memory of Chuck Goddard. Chuck was a lifelong resident of the Welton/DeWitt area in Clinton County. He was an active 4-H member for nine years, followed by four children and several grandchildren in 4-H and/or FFA. His most recent service was on the Clinton County Extension Council for seven years. He strongly believed in the development of youth, placing his highest priority on volunteerism and giving back to the community.

The following criteria will be used to recognize one Clinton County 4-H and/or FFA member each year with a \$1,000 scholarship.

- 1) Be a graduating senior and current member of the Clinton County 4-H program or a Clinton County FFA Chapter.
- 2) Be an active member of 4-H and/or FFA for a minimum of six years.
- 3) Must have shown significant involvement in either the 4-H or FFA programs.
- 4) Must have exhibited a project at the Clinton County Fair a minimum of 4 years.

The \$1,000 scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient's college or trade school upon completion of their first semester.
