To apply for a record keeping project award, you must have submitted records in the project area for a minimum of two years with your most recent enrollment in the project area occurring during the most recent 4-H year. The number of awards given in each project area will be based on the merit of the support materials. A 4-H member may receive no more than one project award in the same year and may only receive an award for the project area once. A 4-H member may select a maximum of two project areas for award consideration. Recipients of 4-H Record Keeping Project Awards will receive a \$100.00 award.
