



It's time to get your YQCA Certifications if you show...  
*Beef, Dairy Cattle/Dairy Goat, Meat Goat, Poultry,  
Rabbit, Sheep, or Swine*

The goal of this program is to help youth and their parents better understand what they can do to produce the safest food possible. 4-12th grade exhibitors **MUST** have their certification complete *before* entering classes in Fair Entry! Youth will have to enter their certificate number when logging in.

**Clinton County youth, please have your certifications complete by May 15th!**

### **Option 1) Web-based Training**

- Step 1— Visit <https://yqcaprogram.org>
- Step 2— Log in
  - 4-H members, sign in with your 4hOnline account
  - FFA members, sign in with your independent account or create one
- Step 3— Select Course
  - Select the course and purchase it for \$12
- Step 4— Complete the course
  - Complete the course and email your certificate to [clinton4h@iastate.edu](mailto:clinton4h@iastate.edu)

### **Option 2) Instructor-Led Trainings**

- Step 1— Register for the training after logging in at <https://yqcaprogram.org>
- Step 2— Pay for the training at registration for \$3\*
  - \*Clinton 4-H members, email [clinton4h@iastate.edu](mailto:clinton4h@iastate.edu) for a coupon code!
  - \*Jackson 4-H members, call 563-652-4923 for a coupon code!
- Step 3— Attend either in-person training
  - March 26 at the Clinton County Extension Office, 3 pm
  - April 30 at Pearson Hall in Jackson County, 3 pm
- Step 4— Complete the post-survey to access your certificate!
