As Iowans adjusted to life during the COVID-19 pandemic, ISU Extension and Outreach continued to prioritize health and safety as we delivered research-based education to the people of Humboldt County. During 2021 we focused on the following virtual or in-person programs.

Farm Succession and Estate Planning Workshop — helping farm families begin conversations and start putting transition plans on paper.

Powerful Tools for Caregivers — Family caregivers of adults with chronic conditions or children with special health or behavioral needs learn ways to take care of themselves, reduce stress, improve their caregiving confidence, and establish balance in their life as they care for others.

Small Change - Building Financial Security — Designed for lowa educators, connects participants with curricula,



resources, and school-based programs for elementary, middle and high school levels. Educators can earn one lowa license renewal credit.

Science of Parenting Workshops —

Parents learn effective parenting techniques involving the building blocks of positive discipline and understanding research and reality.

lowa Learning Farms Field Days — Field days were held with local farmers, exemplifying stewardship and conservation.

ServSafe® — The food safety certification course developed by the National Restaurant Association Educational Foundation for those with oversight and management responsibility in any type of foodservice operation.
