# **Serving the People of Marion County**

As Iowans adjusted to life during the COVID-19 pandemic, ISU Extension and Outreach continued to prioritize health and safety as we delivered research-based education to the people of Marion County. During 2021 we focused on the following efforts:

- Youth gained educational experience through workshops and summer programming. All experiences were research-based and provided hands-on-learning.
- Trunk or Treat was hosted where local businesses and 4
   -H clubs were asked to participate in the event. Over 250 youth walked through the door gaining information on Marion County 4-H.





 Hosted a Rain Barrel workshop. The workshop helped people to understand the benefits, set up and how to use the rain barrels. Each participant went home with a low cost barrel due to donation from partners.

# Showcasing 4-H at the County Fair

The Marion County Fair returned in 2021, providing the opportunity for youth to demonstrate what they had learned through their 4-H project work over the past year.

- Youth took the knowledge of the importance of write-ups, to make theirs stronger in 2021.
- Gained the confidence to share their knowledge with one on one conference judging.
- Youth gained the experience and independence of caring for their animal all week at fair.



## **Working toward Recovery**

As our state works toward recovery, ISU Extension and Outreach Marion County has been supporting Iowans in reviving the Iowa economy, including the farm economy.

 Marion County hosted a Farm to Table event. Worked with local businesses and farms to make sure everything provided came from Marion County. The event had over 60 people in attendance.
