
Working toward Recovery

As our state works toward recovery, ISU Extension and Outreach Van Buren County has been supporting Iowans in reviving the Iowa economy, including the farm economy. The Van Buren County Extension Council chose to address local economic recovery and improving the health of county residents and visitors for FY '21.

The council set aside funds for 10 ServSafe scholarships to award to operations and organizations located within the county who serve food to the public. When notified of the scholarship award, a recipient who owns and operates a bakery stated "I was wondering how many loaves of bread I would have to sell to pay for the class. Your support for this activity is a testimony of the council's commitment to lifelong learning and community outreach!"

Four photo boxes were made available for businesses to photograph items to showcase and advertise on "Shop lowa" at no cost.







Canner Testing Clinic

Ten scholarships were awarded to pay registration fees or local beef producers to attend the "Cattle in the Green" program.

Master Gardener scholarships were offered to pay for registration fees upon completion of the course and volunteer requirements.

Looking ahead to 2022, ISU Extension and Outreach Van Buren County will host a "Van Buren County Road Trip" to showcase county businesses and let visitors know what Van Buren County has to offer.

We will continue to support small businesses, entrepreneurs, farmers, families and individuals with research-based training.

We will continue to grow our 4-H educational opportunities and showcase the work of our 4-H youth. We will provide age appropriate, online and offline learning experiences and resources for K-12 youth.
