## **Township Trustees Training**

## **Beef Quality Assurance**

Together with the Pottawattamie County Cattleman two opportunities for training were held in East Pottawattamie. Forty-five producers took advantage in attending these free trainings and were able to become Beef Quality Assurance certified because of the newly formed partnership.

## **Farmland Leasing**

Twenty-two individuals congregated in August to learn more about current cash and land value leasing results, methods for determining fair rents for 2020, and information on cover crop implementation in leasing agreements. This meeting was led by Patrick Hatting.

## **Farm Bill Meeting**

In December, a partnership meeting with the USDA Farm Service Agency was held to assist producers, landlords, and other agribusiness professionals with ARC/PLC elections, enrollment processes, as well as what additional tools were available to assist with making their decision.

building community relationships. They continue to grow their Science Technology Engineering Math learning opportunities, while growing new partners like the Eckles Memorial Library and the Walnut Public Library. This year, large STEM festivals were held in the AHSTW and Riverside school districts. These were made possible by partnerships from the district leaders and the Southwest lowa STEM Hub. Through these events, nearly 400 youth and adults were reached to engage in opportunities in science, technology, engineering and math on a local level.

East Pottawattamie worked to create a new programming opportunity utilizing Bee Bot robots. This program is directed towards youth in the first and second grades and is held afterschool at the local library. Youth are engaged in coding, reading and team building. Hosting the event at the new venue has also increased book circulation at the libraries.

Fourth grade cooking club continues to be a success. This four week program educates youth on making basic meals, utilizing cooking utensils, and understanding how to read recipes.

There are currently seventeen 4–H leaders assisting ninety -nine 4-Her's and sixty-three Clover kids in growing into tomorrow's leaders.
