## 2023 4-H & FFA Rule Book

When Iowa 4-H members participate in events, those events have rules and protocols to ensure safety and integrity for all participants. 4-H and FFA have shared goals in meeting the need of young people and educating them to become productive citizens. When FFA members are participating in an extension event they are expected to follow the same ethics and rules as 4-Hers.

Aside from the usual date & time changes there were a few minor changes for 2023: See the full rule book to read the entire rule.

- Protest & Appeals- the word complaint has been added
- Grooming Rule- The word guardian has been added.
- Grooming Rule- "another Crawford County 4-H or FFA member exhibiting the same type of livestock at the Crawford County Fair. (For example, a 4-H or FFA member exhibiting beef only may help groom another member's beef exhibit, but not other animals such as swine or sheep.)" has been removed.

## **2023 Crawford County Fair Theme**

The 2022-2023 State 4-H Council is pleased to announce "**Spy Your Potential**" as the 2023 Iowa 4-H Youth Conference Theme. This will also be the theme for the 2023 Crawford County Fair.



## **ID Deadline Schedule**

**FEBRUARY 1:** All market steers and market heifers must be owned and identified in 4-H Online by February 1. By the time of the weigh-in, the animal(s) must be cared for by the 4-H member. In addition to having an official 4-H tag and beginning weight collected, all lowa State Fair market beef must have retinal images collected. FFA must have paper copies turned in.

**MAY 15:** All other animals, with the exception of pets, poultry, and rabbits, must be owned and identified in 4-H Online by May 15. FFA must have paper copies turned in. Static, clothing and communication projects do not need to be ID'd by May 15. They WILL need to be entered into FairEntry by July 1.

**JULY 1:** Rabbits must be identified by July 1 in 4-H Online. By the time of the weigh-in, the animal(s) must be cared for by the 4-H member. FFA must have paper copies turned in.

## **Sheep & Goat Weigh-In**

Sheep & goat weigh-in is scheduled for **Saturday, April 29 from 10:00-noon at the fair-grounds.** Retinal imaging will be available for 4-Hers that plan to attend state fair. If you are showing FFA and plan to show at the state fair your FFA will need to be present to pull hair or you need to make arrangements with them. If you plan to show market sheep or goats you will need to attend on this day or make arrangements to attend another counties weigh-in. Dairy wethers will not weigh in.



## **Swine Tags**

Swine tags are available for pick up at the extension office. \$2.00 per county tag and \$8.00 per state fair DNA tag. **Tags must be tagged and entered into 4-H Online by May 15.** FFA exhibitors showing only at the county fair can get tags at the extension office, if you plan to show FFA at the state fair you will need to work with your FFA advisor.

## **Performance Beef Class**

To help grow the performance beef class there have been a few awards added. In addition to the rate of gain there will be a judges choice award, based on the judges evaluation and a carcass scan award. All of those will be taken into consideration in the overall performance beef winner.

## **Horse Program**

## **Camp 1: Babysitting Basics**

Discover the responsibilities of being a babysitter and caring for babies and children. Learn the basics of keeping children safe, discover how to handle emergencies, practice basic First Aid, and explore ways to make playtime fun with age-appropriate games and activities. All participants receive a book filled with information about childcare as well as a certificate of completion at the end of the course.



## Camp 2: Books for Cooks Camp

Explore culinary skills, including using tools, cooking techniques and kitchen safety! This camp teaches children's fundamental culinary concepts through integrated literacy activities that focus on kitchen skills. Children will get to make and try new foods that they can make at home!



## Camp 3: Make it, Bake it, Take it-Cookie Camp

Do you enjoy baking and eating cookies? At this camp youth will be making store bought sugar cookies from a mix, chocolate peanut butter no bake cookies, baking gluten free flourless cookies, chocolate chip cookies and cookie mix in a jar! Youth will get to practice how to measure wet and dry ingredients, reading directions, what to look for when evaluating cookies as well as working with partners.



## Camp 4: Explorers of the Deep-STEM Camp

Get your ocean robot ready for a research mission! Explorers of the Deep, focuses on the mysteries and adventures of ocean exploration—with robots! Youth learn foundational STEM skills while they wrestle with the same questions as today's top oceanographers and scientist. Other STEM challenges will be included throughout the day.
