#### Reenrollment for 2022-2023

Enrollment for the 2022-2023 4-H year is in full swing! Remember, to be a member in good standing, you must be reenrolled in 4-H Online 2.0 by **January 1st.** You also must go to at least four club meetings to be able to show at ANY fair. So get enrolled right away and attend those meetings!!!

#### **Beef Weigh-In**

Beef weigh-in will take place on **December 29 from 10:00-noon at Denison Livestock**. If there were to be bad weather weigh-in will be moved to the 30. Watch your email, the Crawford County 4-H Facebook page or our webpage if there were to be bad weather.

#### Weigh-in procedure

- Unload calves at the south end of the sale barn.
- Move the calves to the chute for tagging.
- Notify workers if calves are 4-H or FFA and if they will be shown at the Iowa State Fair. Workers will perform retinal imaging for the State Fair.
- Move calves to the scale. Scale workers will help weigh them.
- If the calf is county born, fill out the County Born Forms. Make sure they are turned in today. If you don't have the breeder signature, they can stop at the Extension Office to sign the form.
- Turn in the forms and pay any fees to the person in the stands by the sale ring. \$2.00 per tag, \$5.00 per State Fair retinal image.
- Keep the card as YOU will need to enter the information into 4-H online. This must be done by February 1.
- Load the calves out the southwest side.

#### **ID Deadline Schedule**

**FEBRUARY 1:** All market steers and market heifers must be owned and identified in 4-H Online by February 1. By the time of the weigh-in, the animal(s) must be cared for by the 4-H member. In addition to having an official 4-H tag and beginning weight collected, all Iowa State Fair market beef must have retinal images collected.

**MAY 15:** All other animals, with the exception of pets, poultry, and rabbits, must be owned and identified in 4-H Online by May 15.

**JULY 1:** Rabbits must be identified by July 1 in 4-H Online. By the time of the weigh-in, the animal(s) must be cared for by the 4-H member.

**JULY 1** – YQCA Deadline, Crawford County Fair Entry Deadline & State Fair Entry Deadline

#### **Entering Ear Tags in 4-H Online**

When entering ear tags in 4-H online be sure to list all the digits.

#### Save the Date: Recognition Day

State 4-H Recognition is the process in which senior 4-H members in grades 9-12 can apply to be selected for special statewide opportunities such as awards and trips. The purpose of this event is to provide an avenue for youth recognition and to provide young people with an opportunity to practice and grow leadership, communications, and college and career readiness skills through application and interview activities.

**State Project Area Awards**- State project area awards are awarded to 4-H members who have demonstrated leadership, communication, and service through activities, events, and self-directed learning in a specific project area. Recipients will be provided with a \$100 prize (dependent on funding). Up to 50 project area awards will be presented to Iowa 4-H members in grades 9-12 at the time of application.

**State 4-H Council-** The State 4-H Council is a group of young people who serve as ambassadors for the Iowa 4-H program. This group of high school students works directly with Iowa 4-H Youth Development staff to represent 4-H across the state. They speak to local 4-H groups, present ideas to staff, and work in committees to plan the Iowa 4-H Youth Conference and 4-H members for 4-H campaign. 40 delegates in grades 10-11 at the time of application will be selected.

**National 4-H Congress**- National 4-H Congress is held the day after the Thanksgiving holiday through the following Tuesday in Atlanta, GA. National 4-H Congress is comparable to the "State 4-H Youth Conference," but on a national scale. The event includes dynamic keynote speakers, community service in the Atlanta area, workshops on leadership, cultural issues, and team building. 20 delegates in grades 9-11 at the time of application will be selected, dependent on funding.

State Recognition Day virtual interviews will be held March 18, and in-person interviews on campus on will be March 25.




#### **Clover Cookie Factory Workshop**


#### **Iowa 4-H Enthusiasts: Clothing and Sewing Projects!**
