
A Note from the CYC:

Performance Beef Class

To help grow the performance beef class there have been a few awards added. In addition to the rate of gain there will be a judges choice award, based on the judges evaluation and a carcass scan award. All of those will be taken into consideration in the overall performance beef winner. Scanning will be held Tuesday, July 18th @ 8pm at the fairgrounds.

If you have a specific interest in animal science, you might want to look into becoming part of the **Animal Science ROUND-UP** track!

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) 4-H members exhibiting livestock at both county fairs and lowa State Fair in beef, dairy, meat goat, poultry, rabbit, sheep, or swine are required to be certified.

- Interactive, web-based modules are availa-ble <u>now</u> for all age divisions. A fee of \$12 per member will be collected for maintenance, de-velopment & support of the program and web-site when you login. These modules are age-specific. For those that sold \$250 worth of fruit butter braids you will qualify for a coupon for the course. Please get ahold of the office to receive your coupon.
