The yearly \$40 enrollment fee is an investment in each 4-H member that represents an important commitment to positive youth development in Crawford County. The fee is for all members in grades 4-12 and 4-H enrollment is currently open. You will still need to go to 4-H online 2.0 to enroll or reenroll for the 2023-2024 program year.

Annual volunteer training will be at the extension office on October 16th. 5:30 pm meal and 6:00-7:30 training.


