

ISU Extension and Outreach Mask Mandate

John Lawrence—Vice President for ISU Extension and Outreach has extending the mask mandate for ISU Extension and Outreach to May 8. Masks are required when people are indoors and not able to maintain 6 feet of distance from each other. This includes campus and county extension offices and meeting spaces. Masks are required outdoors if people are within 6 feet of each other. Masks are required when traveling on ISU business with more than one person in the vehicle. Member in Good Standing

Remember, to be a member in good standing, you must be re-enrolled in 4-H Online by February 1st. You also must go to at least four club meetings to be able to show at ANY fair.

If you have a sibling that is now able to join 4-H, simply log on to 4hOnline like usual and just click "Add a new Family Member". If they were in Clover Kids and already have a profile, simply reenroll them but make sure they have a 4-H club selected instead of Clover Kids under the participation tab.

For new families that are wanting to join 4-H, simply have them call the Extension Office or stop by so we can help them set up an account and get information needed for new 4-H members.

YQCA

If you plan to exhibit livestock (beef, goats, poultry, rabbit, sheep and/or swine) at any show or fair you need to complete online YQCA training (FSQA is no longer accepted).

There is a \$12 fee to complete this training. The Crawford County Extension Office will cover the cost to those that sell \$250 worth of fruit and butter braids.



State Fair Livestock Rule Updates

New 4hOnline Process for families for beef, sheep, swine, goat weigh-in's - families will input all information in 4hOnline and county staff will approve it

Beef - acceptable tags USDA (JKD1234) or EID (14-15 digits)

Swine- DNA punch tag required for State Fair and USDA tag (JKD1234) or EID tag (14-15 digits); ractopamine/paylean substance is allowed

Beef/Meat Goat/Sheep/Swine - continue to use the declared weight system

Horse - Eliminating the mini horse

Meat Goat 4-H & FFA - no fit shows (no adhesives, paint, color, oils, other aerosols or powder products); clipping will be allowed

Events—Equine Extravaganza Sept. 24-26, 2021, Animal Science Roundup June 29-July 1, 2021, Dairy Judging Aug. 11, 2021 and Livestock & Meats Judging Aug. 28, 2021

Smithfield Swine Project

Smithfield will be offering the Smithfield Swine Production Class again this year. This will be the second year for this class and we are very excited to be offering it again! A little background about this class is below.

Smithfield hog production has stepped up to help fund this class as they will provide each exhibitor that is interested with four hogs around seventy-five pounds.

The structure of the program would be centered around more of the day to day activities with the kids getting to bring the pigs to the fair. These pigs would show in a separate class of just these hogs and be judged on the uniformity of the group as well as the records that are kept. The day to day activities would be the daily care of the hogs and record keeping. Each exhibitor would need to keep track of the feed, medications, daily observations of the pigs and visitors to the farm. Each exhibitor would also need to conduct a line of separation within the guidelines of the secure pork act and pass a mock site assessment and common swine audit performed by a certified PQA plus advisor.

There is still time to sign up! If you would like to fill out a contract please contact Aubrey at asholty@iastate.edu or 712-263-4697. Pigs will be available for pick-up on April 24 at the fair grounds. 4-Hers that have turned in a contract will receive an email with more information.

Spring is here, HOORAY! Which means we all are getting anxious to get out and spend some quality time with our fuzzy friends. Remember we must always use caution when getting the horses out for the first time in the spring; both you and your horse are going to be a little rusty. Now is the time to start planning and scheduling "spa" treatments for the horses. Start planning or acting on your plan for the following:

Hoof care Worming program Shots Teeth floats


Now is the time to get all your tack out — inspect and clean it up. Keeping your tack in good working condition only keeps you and your horse safe. If something is questionable GET IT REPLACED!!

Starting Tuesday, May 4th thru Tuesday, July 13th we will be having clinics at the Expo building on the fair-grounds 6pm – 9pm. You must attend a minimum of 4 clinics to be able to show at the county fair. These will be progressive clinics building on skills and goals from previous clinics. If you are not able to attend it will be YOUR responsibility to reach out to me to find out what was covered in missed clinics.

I have been talking with Monona County about joining our efforts to build both of our horse programs and provide positive experiences, networking opportunities, and bringing something different to the table. We are still working out the details and it will be a work in process this next year.

Sunday, April 18th at 1pm we will have a trail ride at Southwood in Smithland, IA. I have extended an invite to our Monona County neighbors. We will have a brief meeting on the finishing details to the clinics, and getting some relaxing ride time in. This is a 4-H event, helmets are required! I have tack that fits me and my family, if my tack does not fit you it is YOUR responsibility to acquire your own.
