

I hope you are all recovering from the holidays! I sure am!



Member in Good Standing

Remember, to be a member in good standing, you must be re-enrolled in 4-H Online by February 1st. You also must go to at least four club meetings to be able to show at ANY fair.

If you have a sibling that is now able to join 4-H, simply log on to 4hOnline like usual and just click "Add a new Family Member". If they were in Clover Kids and already have a profile, simply reenroll them but make sure they have a 4-H club selected instead of Clover Kids under the participation tab.

For new families that are wanting to join 4-H, simply have them call the Extension Office or stop by so we can help them set up an account and get information needed for new 4-H members.

If you plan to exhibit livestock (beef, goats, poultry, rabbit, sheep and/or swine) at any show or fair you need to complete online YQCA training (FSQA is no longer accepted).

There is a \$12 fee to complete this training. The Crawford County Extension Office will cover the cost to those that sell \$250 worth of fruit and butterbraids.

State Fair Livestock Rule Updates

New 4hOnline Process for families for beef, sheep, swine, goat weigh-in's

- families will input all information in 4hOnline and county staff will approve it

Beef - acceptable tags USDA (JKD1234) or EID (14-15 digits)

Swine- DNA punch tag required for State Fair and USDA tag (JKD1234) or EID tag (14-15 digits); ractopamine/paylean substance is allowed

Beef/Meat Goat/Sheep/Swine - continue to use the declared weight system

Horse - Eliminating the mini horse

Meat Goat 4-H & FFA - no fit shows (no adhesives, paint, color, oils, other aerosols or powder products); clipping will be allowed

Events—Equine Extravaganza Sept. 24-26, 2021, Animal Science Roundup June 29-July 1, 2021, Dairy Judging Aug 11, 2021 and Livestock & Meats Judging Aug 28, 2021

Landus Cooperative 2020-21 "Excellence in Agriculture" Scholarship

The "Excellence in Agriculture" scholarship awards five \$2,000 scholarships. Area high schoolers pursuing a career in agriculture, life sciences, or an ag-related field are invited to apply.

Scholarship Requirements:

Applicant and/or parent must be a voting member, in good standing, of Landus Cooperative.
Applicant must be a high school senior and graduate in the spring of the 2019/2020 school year.
Applicant must have a cumulative high school GPA OF 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale through their junior year.
Applicant must pursue a career in agriculture or enter an ag-related field of study at any accredited post -secondary school of their choice.
Dependents of directors and officers of Landus Cooperative are not eligible to apply for these scholarships.

Pioneer Grants Available

4-H clubs can apply for "seed money" grants from Pioneer, up to \$500. These grants are to be used by 4-H clubs for community improvement projects in their community. Applications are due Jan. 15, 2021. Application materials, tips, and more are posted on the Pioneer Grant webpage https://www.extension.iastate.edu/4h/ pioneergrants Clubs that opted for the COVID extension on 2020 grants are NOT eligible for 2021.
