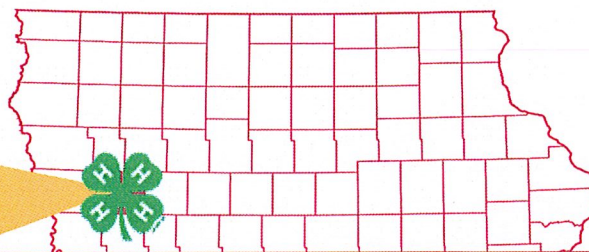

## Foods for Iowa 4-H Fairs– Quick Reference Guide

Food and nutrition exhibits involve fun and engaging food science and nutrition experiments. Exhibits should be prepared with food safety in mind. Using unsafe ingredients or recipes could cause judges who evaluate exhibits to become ill. Plan ahead for a successful fair experience. Use these guidelines to help you select an acceptable product for exhibit, find an approved recipe source, and identify the appropriate preparation method.

## Exhibit Write-Up's

A write up is...

- ☐ An explanation of the work you put into your project
- ☐ A sufficient to provide needed information
- ☐ Explains how the exhibit relates to our project area learning
- ☐ REQUIRED to be attached to every static project you bring to the fair



A write up should explain what you planned to learn/ goals you had for the project. You should also talk about what steps you took to do this and what were the most important things you learned? Write-up's should include your name, grade in school, 4-H club, project area and class number, answer to project goal questions, pictures, receipts, design elements and art principles for required classes, proof of copyright permission if using licensed material, budget breakdown and a resource list . 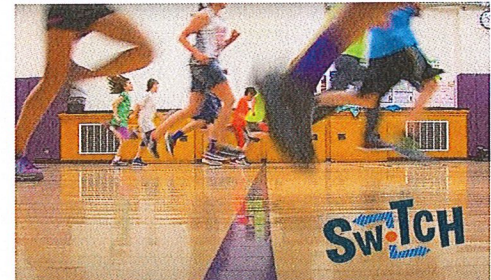
### **Portable Photo Studio**
