4-H CLOVER KIDS

Clover Kids is a fun 4-H program specifically designed for children in kindergarten through third grade. Clover Kids fosters positive relationships and builds valuable life skills through a variety of hands-on activities.

In an effort to hold Clover Kids while also following guidance for social distancing, Iowa State University Extension and Outreach youth staff have created take-home kits with optional virtual components, which will replace our in-person Clover Kids program for 2020-2021. Take home kits enable youth to participate in the Clover Kids activities from home with the option to connect virtually with other youth, guided by their Clover Kids leader. Inside of each Clover Kids kit, you will find supplies for the activities along with directions and information related to connecting with your Clover Kids leader virtually.

Registration: Sign-up for Clover Kids take home activities by completing the enrollment form attached. Return the enrollment form to the Crawford County Extension office at 35 South Main St, Denison, by September 30th.

Cost: \$20 for the 2020-2021 school year

Distribution of kits: Kits will be sent home with kids once a month.
