

## IOWA'S DAIRY INDUSTRY 2020

- 1261 herds
  - 1045-dairy cows; 216- dairy goat; 1 dairy sheep
- 220,000 cows; 34,000 does
  - 12<sup>th</sup> nationally (cows, milk prod.)
  - 9<sup>th</sup> nationally milk prod./cow
- 50 % herds < 100 cows; 15% > 200
- 24,800# milk/cow; 5.6 billion total lbs
- On farm milk \$ value: \$1 billion
- Value added processing: \$2+ billion
- Supports 16,000+ jobs
  - (100 cows = 8 jobs)
- Total impact: \$5.6 billion
- Each cow: \$25,454 local \$\$ activity
