



- ◇ Check in is Sunday, July 19th 6:30-8:30 PM
- ◇ Exhibitors are asked to stay in their vehicle until directed otherwise
- ◇ **NO WEIGH IN OR CHECK IN DAY OF SHOW.**
- ◇ All animals must be checked in on July 19th to show.
- ◇ No overnight stay for exhibitors
- ◇ **Show Starts Monday, July 20th 10:00 AM:**
 - Clover Kids Starts at 10:00 AM
 - Sheep Show immediately following Clover Kids
 - 30 minute break
 - Goat Show immediately following Break
- ◇ Exhibitors are to bring their own woodchips and clean their own pens after show before check out!
- ◇ Animals should be washed and dry prior to fair.
- ◇ No slick sheering allowed.
- ◇ Touch-ups are allowed. Brushes, spray bottles, baby wipes, and touch up gear is permitted.
- ◇ No wash racks, fitting stands or tack in barns.
