## PARKING LOTS

-- Minimum of 2 handicapped spaces or $2 \%$ of the total number of spaces, whichever is greater. No. of spaces
-- $96^{\prime \prime}$ wide with a 54 " wide access aisle - Minimum slope 1:50.

-- Spaces display the "International Symbol of Accessibility," mounted on pole or wall 5' above grade.
-- Curb Ramps minimum width 36" - Slope 1:12.*

-- At least one - 48" wide - Slope not to exceed 1 in 20 or 5\% gradient.

## ENTRANCES

-- At least one primary entrance will be accessible and connected by an accessible walk to parking, public streets or elevator.

DOORS
-- 32" minimum clear width with door opened 90 degrees and measured from the face of the door to the face of the door stop.

-- Doors in series - minimum space shall be 48 " plus width of any door swinging into the space.
-- Thresholds - maximum 1/2".
-- Sliding doors - maximum 3/4".

-- Door Hardware - shall have a shape that is easy to grasp and operate with one hand and does not require tight grasping, pinching or twisting of the wrist to operate.

## STAIRS

-- Open riser stairs are not permitted. Uniform riser heights and tread widths. Yes $\qquad$ No $\qquad$
-- Handrails - shall be provided at both sides of stairs and shall extend 12" on one side beyond the top and bottom riser. Diameter of gripping surface shall be $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ to $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and adjacent to the wall $1-1 \mid 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## RESTROOMS

-- Outer doors minimum 36" plus needed clearance as described for doors in series under doors.

-- Interior -unobstructed floor space of 5 feet in diameter measured 12" above the floor.

-- Toilet Stall - minimum 42" from the latch side of the door and any obstruction.

-- Urinals - At least one shall have an elongated lip with the basin opening 15"-17" above the floor.

-- Lavatory - At least one shall be mounted with a clearance at the bottom of 29 " from the finished floor and height from floor to top not to exceed 34". An unobstructed floor space of 30 "x40" will be provided in front of the lavatory.

-- One set of accessories is mounted no higher than 48 " above the floor.

## WATER FOUNTAINS

-- Height - between 30" and 36" above the finished floor.
-- Controls shall be hand or foot operated.
-- Clearance approach space at least 30 " deep by 48 " wide. $\qquad$

## ELEVATORS

-- Controls accessible by forward reach mounted no higher than 48" above the floor. Side reach mounted no higher than 54" above the floor.

## SIGNAGE

-- If identified as accessible the "international" symbol shall be used.

-- Doors leading to hazardous areas will be marked by knurling, roughening or an abrasive coating to the surface of the door hardware.
