

## Record Book Awards

-All 4<sup>th</sup> grade 4-H members and first year 4-H members will be awarded their 1<sup>st</sup> year pin and certificate at the year-end awards ceremony.

-Each individual record book will be awarded Gold, Silver, or Bronze.

-Club officer record books will be awarded Gold, Silver, or Bronze.

Leaders will:

- Judge their club members' record books by providing feedback and nominating the book for a Gold, Silver, or Bronze award
- Nominate members they feel are deserving of the following record book and senior record book awards:

-All 4<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade 4-H members are eligible to be nominated for the following record book awards and may only win them one time in their 4-H career:

-All 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade 4-H members are eligible to be nominated for the following senior record book awards and may only win them one time in their 4-H career:

Senior Ag and Natural Resources Award  
Senior Animal Award  
Senior Creative Arts Award  
Senior Family and Consumer Science Award  
Senior Personal Development Award  
Senior Science, Engineering, and Technology Award

-All *regular* project record book awards are given to those who complete and excel at in the record keeping for that project area. *Regular* project awards can be won more than once and are the following:

Aerospace, Beef, Child Development, Civic Engagement, Clothing, Communication, Consumer Management, Crop Production, Digital Storytelling, Dog, Entomology, Environment and Sustainability, Food and Nutrition, Forestry, Goat, Health, Home Improvement, Horse and Pony, Horticulture, Leadership, Mechanics and Design, Music, Outdoor Adventure, Photography, Poultry, Rabbit, Robotics, Self Determined, Sewing and Needle Arts, Sheep, Shooting Sports, STEM, Swine, Tractors, Veterinary Science, Visual Arts, Wildlife, Woodworking
