Qualifications/Skills

- Knowledge of beef species and previous experience working with youth and 4-H program
- Strong leadership skills

Primary responsibility: Provide planning and management of East Pottawattamie County 4-H educational presentation event members, provide educational opportunities and coordinate 4-H fair activities.

Primary Duties

- Work with County Youth Coordinator to plan and implement educational presentation judging.
- Make recommendations for judges
- Plan and organize event at County Fair.
- Attend pre and post fair evaluation/planning meetings. Make recommendations for changes
- Be familiar with 4-H rules and regulations
- Represent East Pottawattamie County Extension, Iowa State University Extension and Outreach In a positive manner to the youth and community
- Adhere to rules and regulation of Code of Ethics

Responsibilities of Extension staff

- Update fair book and have fair books available to 4-H members/families
- Prepare and send letter of confirmation to judge
- Send news release and fair results to media
- Order ribbons and trophies
- Provide computer support of entries, classes, show bills, etc.
- Provide training, support and resources
