4-H members are only eligible for awards in project areas they have participated in and completed record book forms for in the current 4-H year. Members may win each award once. 4-H'ers must be a second year member to be nominated.

Outstanding Junior	4-H Member in 5 th – 6 th grades that participates in a variety of 4-H activities and is a good face of 4-H.
Outstanding Intermediate	4-H Member in 7 th – 8 th grades that participates in a variety of 4-H activities and is a good face of 4-H.
Outstanding Senior	4-H Member in 9 th – 12 th grades that participates in a variety of 4-H activities and is a good face of 4-H.
4-H Spirit Award	4-H'er that shows enthusiasm towards the 4-H program and represents the county well
Chris Galitz Memorial Photography Award	Member with outstanding photography records
Bill Sick Memorial Swine Award	Member with outstanding swine records
Boyd Nilan Memorial Beef Award	Member with outstanding beef records
Claire & Marge Vance Memorial Sheep Award	Member with outstanding sheep records
Ralph & Junellyn Pierce Leader in Service Award	Member who has outstanding records in leading through service
Wray Carroll Memorial Award	Member with outstanding goat or sheep records
Senior Agriculture & Natural Resources Award	Senior 4-H member in grades 9-12 with outstanding records in Agronomy, Environment and Sustainability, Horticulture, Outdoor Adventures, Shooting Sports, Entomology, or Wildlife project areas.
Senior Animal Award	Senior 4-H member in grades 9-12 with outstanding records in Beef, Dogs, Goats, Pets, Poultry, Rabbits, Sheep, Swine or Veterinary Science project areas.
Senior Creative Arts Award	Senior 4-H member in grades 9-12 with outstanding records in Digital Storytelling, Music, Photography or Visual Arts project areas.
Senior Family and Consumer Science Award	Senior 4-H member in grades 9-12 with outstanding records in Child Development, Clothing, Consumer Management, Food and Nutrition, Health, Home Improvement or Sewing and Needle Arts project areas.
Senior Personal Development	Senior 4-H member in grades 9-12 with outstanding records in Civic Engagement, Communication, Leadership or Self Determined project areas.
Senior Science, Engineering and Technology Award	Senior 4-H member in grades 9-12 with outstanding records in Computer Science, Mechanics, Woodworking, Tractor, Robotics, Aerospace or STEM project areas.
