Static Help Sheet

Static projects are open to 4-H members, Clover Kids and FFA members

- Enroll in 4-H by November 1, 2019 using [4-H Online](#).
- Attend your monthly club meetings (attending 4 meetings is required to be eligible to participate in the Pottawattamie County Fair) & read the monthly [4-H newsletters](#)
- Register to participate at the Pottawattamie County Fair using the online system, [FairEntry](#). Online static project registration is due by 5:00pm on June 25, 2020.
- Pottawattamie County Fair exhibitors and their families are responsible for reading the 2020 Pottawattamie County Fair Book and agreeing to all rules and regulations prior to the online FairEntry registration and payment.
- Attend Pottawattamie County Fair Set Up to help prep the fairgrounds and barns for livestock, youth and the public.
- Pick up your printed static entry cards from the Extension Office in Oakland on July 8th, the Fair Office in Avoca on July 9th OR on static judging morning, July 15, 2020. Ensure all information on card is correct and attach to project with tape or a string. This tags STAY on your project until exhibits are released at 5pm on Sunday, July 19, 2020.
- Pick up your Static Ribbon Sheet at the check in table in the red and white building when you arrive to static judging. Ensure that all projects listed are correct. Cross off any projects you decided not to bring!
- Get in line to have your static project judged, according to your clubs judging time. Clover kids are judged in the red and white building and 4-H members are judged in the small white judging building across from the red and white building.
- Take all projects WITH the entry cards still attached and display them in your club booth.
- Bring your Static Judging Ribbon Sheet back to the check in table to receive your ribbons. Ribbons may go home with the members or be attached to their project displayed in the club booth the remainder of the week.
- Projects considered for the Iowa State Fair will stay in the judging building and judges will make final decisions at the end of judging. Projects advancing to the Iowa State Fair will be displayed in the State Fair Static Booth for the remainder of fair. Projects considered for state will be taken back to club booths to be put on display.
- Static projects may be picked up from the static booth AFTER 5pm on Sunday, July 19, 2020. Projects taken early will be disqualified.
- Attend Pottawattamie County Fair Clean Up to help clean up the fairgrounds from a long week of fair.
- Ribbon premiums will be distributed to exhibitors in September through the mail.
- Complete and submit a 4-H record book to your club leaders by the club deadline using the suggested [record book guidelines](#).
- Attend 4-H Jamboree awards ceremony in November to receive your record book and awards.
