Enrollment NOW Open

Enrollment is now open for the 2022-23 4-H year! We are excited for a new year to begin. The new enrollment year provides us with new opportunities and goals that each one of us can strive for. It also gives us a chance to reset, learn, and grow as we go throughout the year. If you are interested in returning to 4-H, new to 4-H, or know someone that would be a great fit for the program, you are encouraged to sign up! Enrollment fees are \$15 per member.

Visit https://v2.4honline.com to get enrolled! For returning members, you will log back into your existing account (may need to update a password) and adjust any information that has changed. For new members, you will need to create an account. Select lowa for the state and Emmet for the county. Then you can choose your club and fill out needed information.

Clover Kid enrollments are also open now and are available for K-3rd graders (see the attached flyer for locations and dates/times). The Clover Kids program is separate from the 4-H program, by introducing new skills and fun ways to learn. Clover Kids will need to be signed up using the 4-H enrollment website, using the same directions as above. Enrollment deadline for Clover Kids is September 30th and costs \$30 for the program. Do NOT pay online for Clover Kids! Please pay at the extension office with either cash or check!
