Register in 4hOnline

- Beginning September 1, you can enroll in 4hOnline at <https://v2.4honline.com>. See the monthly newsletters for step-by-step instructions or contact Judy at the Extension Office for assistance. Contact the Extension Office if you would like to join 4-H and need help selecting a club.
- Choose or review your chosen project areas. Be sure to sign up for those you are interested in. Information about project workshops, clinics, weigh-ins, etc. will be sent to those enrolled in project areas. Identify your animals in 4hOnline

- All animals must be identified by May 15. PLEASE DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST DAY.
- The information in 4hOnline will automatically be transferred over to Fair Entry, where you will then select specific show classes, so make sure any and all livestock are identified.

- Complete YQCA Certification**
 - Log in to yqcaprogram.org and register for a web based on instructor led class.

- Register for Fayette County Fair in Fair Entry**
 - Beginning May 20, you may log-on to Fair Entry at fayette.fairentry.com to select fair classes, order a t-shirt, and sign up for stalls/pens.
 - All information must be entered by June 15. When you have successfully completed Fair Entry registration you should see a “THANKS” message and receive an email confirmation of your registration. If you do not see this message, contact the Extension Office for further instructions.
 - Print the invoice with the amount owed and send along with payment to the Fayette County Extension Office, 218 South Main, PO Box 700, Fayette, IA 52142 by June 22.

- Enter State Fair livestock, if desired**
 - Date to start entering projects into Fair Entry varies. Watch the newsletter for more information. Once the start date is confirmed, log-on to Fair Entry under Iowa State Fair and enter the livestock animals you want to take to State Fair. Deadline is July 1.

- State Fair Static Exhibits**
 - Informational packets will be handed out on Static Judging Day to youth who have projects selected for Iowa State Fair. Please read carefully and take note what is expected when preparing exhibits for State Fair along with the deadline of when exhibits need to be at the Extension Office.
 - Return the Exhibit Information Sheet to the Extension Office by the deadline listed so exhibits are entered correctly by Extension staff.

- Turn in your record book**
 - Hopefully you have been working on this all year!
 - Record books are due to your club leader by September 15. After they have been signed by the club leader, leaders must turn in to the Extension Office by October 1 to be judged for county awards.
