Scholarship Program for Fayette County 4-H Member Qualifications:

A \$750.00 scholarship may be awarded to two Fayette County 4-H members each year. Applications are due or postmarked on or before March 2. Scholarships are based 100% on 4-H participation. Money will be paid to the applicant after a college transcript including your name and college name with 2.0 GPA is turned into the Fayette County Extension Office upon completion of the first semester of freshman year of college.

Applicants:

- must have been an active Fayette County 4-H member for a minimum of five years,
- must be a graduating senior in the spring of 2020,
- may enroll in any kind of post-high school education program (two-year or four-year),
- must achieve a minimum 2.0 GPA during the first semester of their freshman year of college, and
- must submit a minimum of 4 years of 4-H records with the application for consideration.

If awarded, applicant must turn a completed 4-H record book in to the Extension Office by October 1 of the current 4-H year.

Selection will be made on involvement in Fayette County 4-H along with leadership and civic learning (citizenship) by members of the Fayette County Youth Development Committee and two outside sources.
