#### 4-H Records are Due!

<u>All</u> project and Senior Overall records are due to the Extension Office by Thursday, **August 31**, 4:30 p.m. Members are required to turn in a record for each project they are enrolled in. Members are not required to take an exhibit to the fair for their project. Project records are a record



of the member's goals, what they learned while achieving those goals, and their future plans in the project. Remember, your fair exhibits questions sheets can be completed and used for project records!

Overall Yearly Summary records are a record of what 4-H activities the member has participated in this past year. 4-H activities include those activities within the club, county, region, as well as statewide 4-H activities. Intermediates and Juniors turn in overall records to club leaders by August 31.
