#### **County Beef Weigh-In**

Franklin County 4-H and FFA members wishing to weigh-in beef calves are asked to bring them the Ellsworth Community College Equine Center, Iowa Falls, on Saturday, **December 9, 8:00-10:00 a.m.** All mar-



<u>ket</u> steers, heifers, and return bucket calves need to be weighed and ear tagged. Retinal scanning will be available for verifying State Fair cattle. Cost is \$10 per head for retinal scan.

#### **Beef and Equine Blast**

Beef and Equine Blasts are programs for 7th-12th grade students interested in beef cattle production or horses. The program focuses on real-world topics that impact the beef and equine industry and youth producers. Students do not have to be enrolled in 4-H or own beef cattle or equine.

Feedlot fundamentals is the theme of Beef Blast and will cover nutrition, selection, welfare, and marketing of beef cattle. The equine blast theme is Horse Ownership 101 and includes programs on nutrition, welfare, and tack.




### **Books for Cooks**

Books for Cooks is a Iowa 4–H curriculum that supports the development of culinary and literacy skills for K–3 youth. Combining culinary concepts through literacy activities. Each month features a different theme. This month's lesson Let's Taco Bout Spices included the book read Dragons Love Tacos by Adam Rubin, everyone practiced measuring spices and we made our own taco seasoning. Youth were excited to take their seasoning home and they them with their families. The taco seasoning recipe we used is on the bottom of this page. Try making this with your family the next time you have tacos.

## TACO SEASONING MIX





2 tablespoons chili powder

**INGREDIENTS** 

- 1 tablespoon cornstarch
- 1 tablespoon crushed dried red pepper
- 1 tablespoon garlic powder
- 1 tablespoon dried oregano
- · 1 tablespoon ground cumin

Combine all ingredients. Mix well.
Place in a storage container with a
tight-fitting lid. Seal tightly.
Store in a cool, dry place for up to one year.
Stir or shake well before each use.
Use this mixture instead of purchased taco
seasoning mixes. Measure 2 tablespoons per
pound of ground meat.

#### 4-H College Scholarships

The Iowa 4-H Foundation is pleased to announce the 2023 scholarship programs for Iowa 4-H'ers attending or planning to attend college fall 2024. More than 90 scholarships are available to Iowa 4-H'ers pursuing various fields of study at an Iowa Regent university, Iowa private college, or Iowa community college. Applications are available on-line and will open December 1, and are due on March 1, 2023.

Iowa 4-H members are eligible to apply for 4-H scholarships if they meet individual scholarship requirements (i.e. designated college and/or major program of study, county of residence, 4-H event participation, etc.) Applicants must enroll as a full-time student (minimum of 12 credit hours) to receive scholarship awards. Only ONE application form is needed for all Iowa 4-H scholarships. Eligible Iowa 4-H youth may apply for more than one scholarship, however, only one scholarship per individual will be awarded per academic year. Please visit the links below for more information.
