

Fremont County Fair Weigh-In Help Sheet

No early arrivals for any species

For Swine, Sheep, & Goats: Wednesday, July 13th starting at 6pm

Families will need to come through the North Gate of the fairgrounds and jump in line between the show ring and the McElroy building to allow for easy pull up and back in at the unloading shoot when it is your turn.

Exhibitor needs to be present for weigh-in

All animals will be vet checked on the trailer before being unloaded to stall.

All animals must have a drug affidavit on hand to be weighed in (can be found on our website).

We will need to know if you are sending your animal to market or taking them home? – sheep & goat

If you need to change a class, we need to know before they come across the scale.

Carcass Classes

- Swine minimum weight 230 pounds and maximum weight is 300 pounds
- Sheep minimum weight is 110 pounds
- Goats minimum weight is 65 pounds (Goats must be shaved to participate)

Exhibitor meetings following the conclusion of weigh-in

All exhibitors will be **required** to check out with their superintendent following the conclusion of the Premium Sale on Monday – this will allow for stalls to be torn down and placed in piles for Fair Board to move

For Horse: Thursday, July 14th at 7AM

- Vet checks will be conducted at the trailers. All horses are to remain at their trailers until after a successful vet check
- Exhibitors will be handed patterns for the show following the vet checks
- Show clothing: Armbands are required (left arm), white shirt with convertible collar, jeans, helmet, and hard soled shoes
 - o Appropriate attire for English riding
- Arm bands and rule books are available at the Extension Office if needed

For Beef: Thursday, July 14th 7PM

All beef will be check on or at the trailer before stalling and weighing-in at the County Fair.

Drug affidavit needs to be in hand for weigh-in (can be found on our website).

Exhibitor needs to be present for weigh-in

Breeding Beef – need registration papers turned into the office prior to weigh-in unless showing commercial

Let us know who will be sending beef to market straight from fair

Weigh-in will take place in the show ring

Exhibitor meeting following conclusion of weigh-in

All exhibitors will be **required** to check out with their superintendent during exhibit release on Sunday or following the conclusion of the Premium Sale

For Rabbits & Poultry

Pullorum Testing for Poultry will occur at the Fremont County Vet Clinic **Wednesday, July 13th from 7:45-8:45** – all birds to be shown at fair will need to be tested

You will need to register for a PT testing time on FairEntry

Fair check in/weigh-in will occur in the rabbit, poultry, goat barn **Friday, July 15th at Noon** – do not unload/uncage until instructed to do so

All rabbits must have ear tattoos

Exhibitor needs to be present for weigh-in
