A Leadership Plan

Greene Leadership 2019 focuses on individual skill building and developing the self-confidence of participants to get involved in their communities. The focus is on helping participants better understand themselves and others, build effective work teams, and improve communication skills. The program also brings understanding of differences in management styles and key elements of effective leadership.
