After School On-The-Go Kit Descriptions:

Seed Germination Necklace-

Have you ever thought about what it takes for a seed to grow? Do seeds need sunlight to grow? You are going to try an experiment to find out.

This to-go lesson leads youth through an experiment to determine what conditions seeds need in order to grow.

Cover Crop Monsters-

When a farmer plants a crop to provide protection for the soil in between cash crops, those are called cover crops. Cover crops provide a root structure to hold the soil in place to prevent erosion, which occurs when topsoil is gradually lost due to wind or water.

For this activity you will create a cover crop monster, which will help you see how quickly grasses germinate and provide ground cover.

Eiffel Tower Artwork-

The Eiffel Tower is an iconic landmark in Paris, France, built in 1889 to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the French Revolution. At the time of construction, the Eiffel Tower was the tallest tower in the world at 1,024 feet offering panoramic views of Paris.

Learn about the Eiffel Tower, and create a piece of artwork representing it. Reflect on other landmarks in your community or country.

Glowing Germs-

The health of your animals is very important. Whether on the farm or at a show, you should be mindful of diseases that could make your animal very sick. But what about the diseases that can make your animal sick and can also make you sick? In this activity, you will see how easily germs can spread between you and your animal.
