LIVESTOCK ID DEADLINES

Remember that exhibitors must ID livestock on 4-H online to make them eligible to show at fair. This is step 1 of the 2-step process to be able to show in any 4-H/FFA show.

Entry & ID process

- Step 1: ID Deadlines in 4-H Online: accepted until 11:59 pm
 - ⇒ Market Beef (also weighed-in) Feb. 1
 - ⇒ Breeding Beef, Market Swine, Sheep, Goats, Dairy Cattle, Horse & Dog May 15
 - ⇒ Poultry, Rabbits, 4-H Bucket Bottle Calves, June 15
 - ⇒ Pre 4-H Bucket Bottle Calves and Lambs—July 1
- **One on one help at the Extension office Monday-Friday 8:00 am-4:30 pm.
- Step 2: Fair Entry deadline: July 1
 - ⇒ Visit hancockdf.fairentry.com to log-in to the FairEntry system (open June 1).
- **There will be help sheets available along with one on one help in our office Monday-Friday 8:00-4:30 pm.

YQCA - REQUIRED TRAINING

HANCOCK COUNTY 2023 REQUIRED YQCA TRAINING

ALL 4-H (4th-12th grade) and FFA exhibitors who plan to show beef, sheep, swine, dairy, rabbit, poultry, or goats at County or State Fair MUST be YQCA certified.

WHAT ARE MY OPTIONS?

- 1. You can attend a face-to-face YQCA training. Class sizes are limited and you must pre-register at yqcaprogram.org. (\$3 fee).
- 2. You can participate in the online YQCA training at yqcaprogram.org (\$12 fee).
- 3. You can test out if you are 12 or 15 years old as of January 1 (fee is determined upon what test option you are taking). Contact Extension Office for more information about this option.

Exhibitors **MUST** be certified by **July 1** to exhibit at the fair (both county and state)

Sign-up online at yqcaprogram.org for online trainings and face-to-face trainings.

Are you looking to get started in showing sheep? Or maybe you are just looking for a new breeder? Check out the Lotto Lamb opportunity!

The lambs will be purchased from a reputable breeder by your sheep superintendents. You will pick up your lambs at weight in on April 15th. Lotto Lamb sign up deadline is March 15.

Cost: Each lamb will cost \$350, and there is a required \$75 per lamb down payment.

Sign Up: Contact the Extension Office at xhancock@iastate.edu to get a sign up form or download one from our website. A \$75 down payment per lamb and sign up form is required by March 15th to secure your lamb(s). You can purchase up to 3 lambs.



BUCKET BOTTLE

The Bucket Bottle Calf/Lamb/ Goat show is for Preschool - 8th grade at the Hancock County District Fair.

Here is a reminder of the rules for this popular show:

- Calf/lamb/goat must be born between March 1- June 1 of the current year.
- Exhibitor must take possession of animal within 2 weeks of birth.
- Pre 4-H animals must be tagged and identified on paper by July 1. (4-H animal must be tagged and identified in 4-H Online by June 15)
- All bucket bottle animals must submit an entry in the FairEntry system by July 1 at 11:59 pm.
- Animal must be bucket or bottle fed, no nursing.
- Animal will be shown at halter in the show ring.
- "Judging" will be based on knowledge of exhibitor and health of calf/lamb/goat.

ALL BUCKET BOTTLE ANIMALS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A **HEALTH PAPER UPON ARRIVAL** TO THE FAIRGROUNDS.


