Who: 4th -12th graders who might possibly show in a market class, including bucket bottle return and pen of three MUST have a beginning weight.

Where: Hancock County District Fairgrounds (Farm Bureau Building)

All Hancock County beef must have TWO forms of identification. Ear tag and county tattoo will be provided at weigh in for county animals at the cost of \$3.00 per tag.

Reminder: Anyone wishing to show their animal at the lowa State Fair MUST get their animal retinal scanned. Retinal scanning is an extra \$5.00 per head fee.


