Requirements:

- Be a graduate 4-Her who has completed their senior year of high school.
- Enter at least two (2) 4-H exhibits of any kind (livestock, static, or communications) in the Hancock County Fair the summer following graduation from High School. The scholarship will not be awarded if the recipient did not enter at least 2 fair exhibits.

Iowa State Fair

• Plan to attend a college, university or trade school the summer, fall or winter following High School graduation.



- Have completed a Record Book for the previous year in 4-H (turn in a record book for this past 4-H year that is ending now). Preference will be given to applicants who have completed a Record Book for the previous 4 years.
- Have a GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

Graduates: Be sure that you don't forget to apply for the Bock Scholarship in the midst of life transitions. Completing a record book can be simple, don't let it scare you away from this great opportunity!

12th graders: File this for next summer/fall and don't forget that this great opportunity is available to you!

RECORD BOOKS & RECOGNITION

Record Keeping and Awards are completed and applied for at the end of the 4-H year. This can be done in a socially distant world and it can be done even if you didn't participate in the fair.

Our deadline for award applications and record completion recognition is September 15, 2023.

Many of you are deserving of the awards that are offered to 4-Hers who exemplify excellent leadership, citizenship, character, enthusiasm, and service. Please consider applying or asking your club leader to nominate you.

Instead of holding a county wide award ceremony, we will continue with our social media and virtual recognition and would be happy to present awards at club meetings by request.

There are 2 main categories where 4-Hers can receive awards.

Bronze, Silver, or Gold project record completion

Project record completion awards are not competitive. If you meet the requirements found on the "Project Record Completion Application" you will receive a bronze, silver, or gold; depending on which level you applied for. You must also submit your records related to that project. These records can be submitted in many forms: in a book with all your 4-H projects, in a binder (or other method of filing) related to just that project area, or a video or other electronic document.

Competitive Awards

These awards can only be won once during each age division of 4-H (Jr. 4-6th grade, Int. 7-8th



grade, Sr. 9-12th grade or age category depending on the award). The Sweers and Greiman family awards are great honors that 4-Hers

should check out! Some are judged exclusively on the applications or additional materials may be required. (your 4-H records, your school transcript, etc). The award selection is competitive and will be judged based on your application, record book, and any other supporting material the specific award asks for.

Leader nominated awards are due October 1st and include nomination awards for 4-Hers, awards for the club to win, nominations of outstanding volunteers.

Fees: NONE! \$40 fee to join Iowa 4-H is generously being paid by NEW Coop and Hancock County Extension Council! The enrollment fee is a one time fee that is paid to Iowa 4-H for membership in club programs. Additional fees may apply for county wide workshops or for club specific events.

Why: 4-H members are proven to be more likely to serve the community, have more confident leadership and communication skills, learn project or topic specific skills, and build relationships with lifelong friends.

Types: 4-H has community clubs, project pop up clubs, LEGO teams, and more.
