1. Picked out the first saying and place plastic bag over top of saying.
2. Use washable marker to color lines/blocks/shapes throughout the plastic bag.
3. Remove white paper from underneath the Ziplock and spritz the top of bag with water.
4. Place white paper on top of the Ziplock and press in a smoothing motion to spread the colors.
5. Remove the paper from the Ziplock and allow to dry.
6. Place in frame once dry.
