**My goal: What did you plan to learn or do?**

I wanted to learn how to make 3D art and how to work with aluminum foil.

**What I did in achieving my goal (in steps): What steps did you take to learn or do this? What decisions did you make in accomplishing your goal?**

1. Select objects for either a random or planned design, glue in place. How did you choose your design? Talk about how you created balance, how did you pick your shapes to have unity?
2. Crumple aluminum foil and open back up. Crumpling tighter or looser will change the look that will happen. Which look are you going for and why?
3. Lay foil over canvas and secured objects. Rub gently to smooth and outline textured items.
4. Dampen foil with water, use black paint to "antique" the foil, gently rub surface areas clean adding water if needed.
5. "Dry brush" metallic paint color of choice on and around textured items. "Blend" around the items.
6. Add hook to the back for hanging.

Be sure to add in decisions that you made that were your own and how you made your choices.

**What I learned: What were the most important things you learned?**

Be careful that you don't rip the aluminum foil.

The look of the shapes change once they are covered up.
