I wanted to learn how to design leather earrings using Cricut Design space.

What I did in achieving my goal (in steps): What steps did you take to learn or do this? What decisions did you make in accomplishing your goal?

1. I drew out the design I wanted on paper to know what it would look like. Talk about proportion to your face and how big you wanted the earrings to be.
2. I learned about Cricut design space and how to find or make the shape I wanted cut out for my earrings.
3. I picked out the leather for my earrings. Be sure to talk about how you decided on the color and the pattern and how you made them match if you had layered earrings.
4. Workshop helpers cut out the earrings with the Cricut.
5. I choose the type and color of hook that I wanted and very carefully put them on the earrings using the pliers.

What I learned: What were the most important things you learned?

How to pick colors and patterns that look good together and look good with my clothing.

Be careful with the pliers so you don't break or scratch the earring hooks.

Techniques for layering earrings or doing feathering on earrings (if this applies to your earring).

Be sure to double check the size of the design before you print it out so you don't end up with tiny or gigantic earrings that don't fit your face size and would look silly to wear.
