# Pre 4-H Youth Feeder Calf

Pre 4-H Youth Class, (preschool thru 3<sup>rd</sup> grade)

1. The Open Class is for youth whom have not reached the eligible 4-H grade. These participants are age 3 thru 3<sup>rd</sup> grade.
2. Any newborn dairy or beef calf (steer or heifer) calved between January 1 and June 1 of the current year. Must be in possession of the participant within two weeks of birth.
3. Feeder calves must ID'ed by July 1<sup>st</sup> by turnin in the ID form.
4. Feeder calves must enter the fair by July 1<sup>st</sup> by entering online in FairEntry at [hancockdf.fairentry.com](http://hancockdf.fairentry.com). A \$25 late fee is charged after July 1<sup>st</sup>.
5. Animals must be nursed.
6. Any participant may identify two (2) animals, and exhibit two (2) at the county fair as long as they are in different classes (a heifer and a steer). The calf is not eligible to be sold at the Fair Auction. Eligible animals can be shown only in the Feeder Calf class.
7. Calves will be shown at halter. Calves may be divided into classes depending on number of entries at discretion of superintendents.
8. Judging will be based on conformation or quality of the calf.

10. 3<sup>rd</sup> grade participants may keep animals for dairy, breeding or market beef project the following year. Returning feeder calves must be weighed and tagged as a market beef for the next year's fair.
