My goal: What did you plan to learn or do?

My goal was to decorate a canvas using only paint, bubble wrap, and a paint brush.

What I did in achieving my goal (in steps): What steps did you take to learn or do this? What decisions did you make in accomplishing your goal?

1. I first picked my colors of paint I wanted. I had the choice to use only 4 or less colors, we talked about complementary colors and how to use the color wheel.
2. I then took my paint brush and brushed the lumpy side of the bubble wrap. I made sure I was careful to only paint the bubbles themselves so the paint wouldn't smear around
3. I flipped over the bubble wrap and lightly pressed it on to the canvas. It was important to make sure you applied equal pressure to the piece of bubble wrap in order to get even amounts of paint spread out.
4. I then repeated these steps until I had my canvas full of bubble wrap art
5. After my canvas was full, I glued on the piece of bubble wrap that I painted to make a textured look to the canvas in one spot.

What I learned: What were the most important things you learned?

I learned that it was important to make sure I had the same amount of paint spread evenly across my bubble wrap to ensure it looked in unity. I also learned that using bubble wrap can create different texture to a painting.
