



Being that Veterans Day is November 11, I'd like to shed a little light on one of the most honored traditions of this Remembrance Day - the poppy! You may see Veterans hand out these little flowers around Memorial Day and Veterans

Day...and there is a reason for that! Read along for some fun facts about the poppy and its significance to the National American Legion Auxiliary!

-The tradition started after World War I in November 1918 (100 years ago!)

-Moina Michael was inspired by Lt. Col. McCrae's poem, "In Flanders Fields".

-She then bought a bouquet of poppies and handed them out to businessmen at the New York YMCA.

-The poppy became the official flower of the American Legion on September 27, 1920

-By donating in return for a poppy from the American Legion Auxiliary, you are helping support veterans!

1. Go to <https://iowa.4honline.com> (you might want to bookmark this page)
2. Logged in before: Select 'I have a Profile'. Enter family email address and password.
3. New user: Select: 'I forgot my password" Check your email - you will have a password emailed to you - use that password on the login screen for 4-H Online (you will have to choose a new password)

The Iowa Cattlemen's Foundation is proud to host the Beef Scholarship Extravaganza. It is one of the most challenging and rewarding youth cattle competitions in the nation. Young people who participate in this event reap the benefits of their preparation long after the competition is over.

The contest is open to high school juniors and seniors who will test their knowledge on the beef industry and beef cattle management issues. Stations cover the following topics:

Each station will be worth 100 points, and participants will receive explanation and feedback about the stations following the competition.

Scholarship dollars won at the Extravaganza can be used at any university or community college. In addition, if the student will be attending Iowa State University College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, Kirkwood Community College, Hawkeye Community College, Muscatine Community College, Des Moines Area Community College, or Iowa Lakes Community College, those institutions may offer additional matching scholarships to students on the winning teams.

This one-day event is open to teams of either two or three current juniors and/or seniors. Team members do not need to be from the same high school or county. *In the case of a three-member team, only two will participate at each station (as decided by the team); the third will be an observer. However, all team members will share the team award.*

The entry fee is \$200 per team. The fee covers noon lunch and an Extravaganza t-shirt. Finalized details of the day's itinerary including station protocols will be sent to registered teams and posted at www.iowacattlemen'sfoundation.org.


