2022 Citizenship Washington Focus

Citizenship Washington Focus (CWF) is a 4-H leadership and civic engagement program for high school youth (completed grades 9-12 at the time of the trip). Each summer teens gather in Washington DC to learn what it means to be a strong leader in their community, country, and world. Objectives for the program are: Strengthen communication, leadership, and other citizenship skills on a national level, Understand the importance of civic and social responsibilities as they relate to the development of better citizens and leaders, Exchange ideas, practice respect, and form friendships with other youth from diverse backgrounds. Experience hands-on learning using the historical backdrop of our nation's capital city, Washington, D.C. These objectives are met through pre-trip education, speakers, workshops, daily excursions to view national sites, a day at the Capitol with elected officials, and a delegate designed and implemented action plan.

Trip Date: June 17-24, 2022 Trip cost is \$1800. This includes all lodging, travel, tours, and a majority of meals. A \$600 non-refundable deposit is due at the time of registration by debit/credit card. The remaining balance is two payments of \$600 each due on March 15 and April 15, 2022. Financial assistance and fundraising options are available.

DePont Pioneer Seed Grant



Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) is a national multi-species quality assurance program for youth ages 8 to 21 (4th– 12th graders) with a focus on three core pillars: food safety, animal well-being, and character development.

YQCA will be replacing the old verification services called FSQA. YQCA certification is the new required youth quality assurance certification. If you are planning on showing any of these animals you need to complete YQCA.

- Swine
- Cattle
- Sheep
- Goats
- Rabbits
- Poultry

YQCA is available as an online program for youth, you can now view it on your own time.

The way to complete this training is it go to http://yqca.org/, sign in using your 4-H Online log in. There is a \$12 fee per child to go with this training (if you need financial assistance please contact the office) which is paid when you log in your child.
