State Fair Sheep and Goat Update

Reminder for those planning to exhibit sheep and/or meat goats (both breeding and market animals) at the **State Fair** that retinal imaging will not be taking place. Instead 4-H'ers are required to upload 3 photos to 4-H Online by June 1st:

- Clear, readable picture of 4-H USDA tag in the animal's ear
- Left, full side view of the animal
- Right, full side view of the animal
