As a 4-H volunteer:	
1.	I will make a conscious effort to ensure that all youth have access to the 4-H Youth Development program.
2.	I will not manufacture, distribute, dispense, possess, use, or be under the influence of illegal drugs and/or alcohol while I have responsibility for youth involved in the 4-H Youth Development program.
3.	I will not abuse any youth or adult program participant (abuse as defined in the Code of Iowa). A copy of the appropriate Iowa code, section 232.68 (1995), is available in the County Extension Office.
4.	I will comply with State of Iowa motor vehicle-related regulations and laws when transporting 4-H youth.
5.	I will participate in training and accept guidance and support from ISU Extension staff and other volunteers.
6.	I will not use the volunteer position for private, personal, or commercial financial gain.
I have read the Iowa State University Extension Youth Safety and Well-being Agreement and understand that compliance is a condition for continuing involvement as a 4-H volunteer.
