Host/Hostess Duties:

- All hosts and hostesses must wear 4-H t-shirts.
- **Three 4-H members plus at least one adult must be present during each timeslot** The adult does not have to be a leader; it can be another screened volunteer. If a parent is not screened, please contact the Extension Office to request a background check.
- **New this year: You will be responsible for running the ice cream machine and ice cream sales during your shift.** Instructions will be provided to you closer to time on how to do this. A staff member or volunteer will check in with each shift to answer any questions.
- Be welcoming and courteous to the public at all times. Help locate exhibits for the viewing of the public. Make yourself aware of interesting exhibits in the building to point out to the public.
- **HELP PROMOTE 4-H.** Answer questions about the 4-H program.
- Move about the exhibit area to help safeguard all exhibits. **Please, do not just sit at the table.** No one is to touch any of the exhibits. Food and drink are not allowed near the exhibits. If you see someone touching the exhibits, or eating or drinking near the exhibits, kindly ask them not to.
- Once during your shift, please sweep the floors. Make sure not to get too close to projects sitting on the floor.
- **DO NOT** leave until the next group has arrived for their shift. If they are more than 10 minutes late, contact an Extension staff member.
