

Jefferson County Ultimate Showmanship Show

General rules, regulations and health requirements apply

Sunday, June 30 - 11 AM in the Show Arena

Show Rules

1. There will be four species shown for the Jefferson County Ultimate Showmanship Show: Sheep, Goats, Swine, and Cattle.
2. If a member is showing one of the four species mentioned above during the 4-H/FFA show, they will show their own animal that was shown earlier in the week at the fair during this show. If the member does not show one of the above species, they will work with another 4-H/FFA member on borrowing an animal to show. It is recommended that you reach out to other members to find an animal to borrow prior to show day.
3. Age Divisions: Juniors (4th-6th Grade), Intermediates (7th-9th Grade), and Seniors (10th-12th Grade).
4. Showmanship shirts will be worn during the Ultimate Showmanship Show. Static only exhibitors will need to sign up by the May 15th deadline to receive a shirt. All livestock exhibitors will receive a shirt due to entering a showmanship class during fair.
5. An exhibitor number will be provided for each participant
6. This will be a no-fit showmanship show, but all animals should be clean upon entering the show ring.
7. During the show the following criteria will be considered in determining the Overall Showman: exhibitor's ability to show and control the animals in the show ring, exhibitor's appearance in the show ring, and exhibitor's attitude toward animals and judge.
8. The top 5 of each class for each species will be recognized. Exhibitors will receive points based off their placing in each class. The exhibitor with the highest number of points will be the Overall Showman. If there is a tie in points, the youth with the most 1st place wins will be the winner. If there continues to be a tie, the judge will make the final decision, or if not all youth showed all 4 species, the youth that did will win.
9. The Overall Grand and Reserve Showmanship winner will receive an award along with the top 3 in each age division.
10. Any member that participated in a showmanship class or that intends to show in the Ultimate Show will be required to attend a mandatory meeting where they will write thank you cards to the sponsors. This will occur 1 hour before the show starts. Please see Fair Schedule for time.
11. Show order will be by age division starting with Seniors, Intermediate, then Juniors
12. To sign-up to participate in this show, all static only exhibitors must sign up by May 15th. Any livestock exhibitor must sign up by 10 AM on the day of the show.
13. All exhibitors must confirm registration and pick up their exhibitor number at the Cambridge Building at 10 AM the day of the show.
